

Integrated disease surveillance system


Prevalence of skilled birth attendance has improved by 17 percentage points



^{**} The baseline and latest values are not as per definition of safely managed sanitation. The papulation having access to unshared toilet and hand washing facility is 68% and 54% respectively (PSLM 2019-20).
